St. Clair County Animal Control Investigation in Kenockee Township

St. Clair County Animal Control (SCCAC) began an investigation in Kenockee Township after receiving a citizen complaint. Officers have been on site beginning Tuesday, September 1, 2020 and found the dogs in inadequate living conditions. The owner has surrendered more than 80 dogs to the SCCAC.

The staff at SCCAC are placing the dogs in appropriate shelters. Once the dogs have received a medical assessment, the shelters will advise the public on the availability of adoption.

According to Melissa Miller, Director of SCCAC, "Dogs are required to have adequate shelter and protection from the elements, access to clean water and food." Director Miller began her employment with St. Clair County on September 1, 2020.

Further details will be provided upon the conclusion of the investigation.
