Health Department Offering COVID-19 Vaccine and Testing Onsite Self-Schedule Appointments Available

The St. Clair County Health Department is currently scheduling COVID-19 vaccinations and testing appointments at the Health Department Main Office located at 3415 28th Street, Port Huron *and* Teen Health location, 2215 Court Street, Port Huron.

Appointments can be self-scheduled at the Main Office location via www.scchealth.co or by calling the Health Department (810) 987-5300 or the COVID-19 Informational Hotline (810) 966-4163. Vaccine selections will include Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson.

For appointments at the Teen Health location call (810) 987-1311.

COVID-19 Vaccination appointments are offered:

 Monday through Thursday at the Main Office (ages 12 and older) and Teen Health location (ages 12-21)

COVID-19 Testing appointments are offered:

Monday through Friday at both locations

Dr. Annette Mercatante, Medical Health Officer for the St. Clair County Health Department stated, "We are excited to integrate COVID-19 vaccine and testing into our normal services and provide the community ample opportunity to these important tools."
