***St. Clair County Health Department Walk-In Flu Vaccine Clinics Begin September 6***

Beginning September 6 through November 22, 2017 flu vaccines will be available on a walk-in basis every Monday from 10:00am until 6:00pm and Wednesday from 8:00am until 4:00pm at the Health Department located at 3415 28<sup>th</sup> Street in Port Huron. Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays by appointment. Flu vaccines will also be available, by appointment, for those 10-21 years of age, at the Teen Health Center located at 2215 Court Street on the campus of Port Huron High School. \*\*Please note: the St. Clair County Health Department will be closed September 27 from 12:00pm to 4:30pm for staff training.\*\*

St. Clair County Health Department will be administering flu shots which protect against four (4) strains of flu. Available again this year, at the Health Department, will be High Dose flu vaccine, which protects adults 65 years of age and older against three (3) strains of flu. A flu vaccination is necessary every season, as immunity can wane and flu strains may change. The best prevention anyone 6 months of age or older has against flu is to get vaccinated.

For those who are uninsured or underinsured, cost will vary based on income eligibility and family size. Most insurance is accepted and consider flu vaccination a covered benefit.
