As vaccine preventable diseases are on the rise, it is important to protect yourself and your family. Diseases like hepatitis A, measles, mumps and rubella are making a comeback and unvaccinated St. Clair County residents are not immune. In an effort to meet vaccination needs in outlying areas of the county, the St. Clair County Health Department is offering two offsite clinics with hepatitis A and MMR (Measles-Mumps-Rubella) vaccines on May 22 from 4:00 – 7:00 PM. Vaccines will be available for those aged 18 and older. The hepatitis A vaccine will be available at no cost; insurance will be billed for MMR (please bring insurance card).
