June 27 is National HIV Testing Day. Do you know your status? The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) estimates about 1 in 7 people with HIV don't know they have it. This year's theme, **#DoingItMyWay** is part of the Act Against AIDS initiative created to build awareness for HIV testing and prevention. HIV testing should be a part of every adult's health routine, in order to know your status and stay healthy.

The St. Clair County Health Department offers confidential rapid HIV testing, by appointment, at two locations.
