Rapid HIV Testing Now Available at St. Clair County Health Department

According to the CDC, about 1 in 8 Americans with HIV do not realize they are infected and account for nearly one-third of HIV transmissions in the United States. Do you know your status? The St. Clair County Health Department now offers rapid HIV testing with results in approximately 20 minutes. Testing is done using a simple finger stick method and includes a low cost health assessment.

Testing is available for all ages at the Main Office, 3415 28th Street, Port Huron:

By appointment, Mondays 10:00am – 6:30pm and Fridays 8:00am – 4:30pm

Walk-in (no appointment needed), Tuesdays 8:00am – 11:00am and 1:00pm – 3:00pm

The Teen Health Center, located at 2215 Court Street, Port Huron (on the campus of Port Huron High School), also offers rapid HIV testing by appointment Monday through Friday, for individuals 10-21 years of age. Walk-ins accommodated as schedule allows. Contact (810)987-1311 for details.
