***St. Clair County Health Department Identifies Hepatitis A Exposure  
Related to National Frozen Strawberry Recall***

The St. Clair County Health Department is reporting that the Michigan Departments of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) and Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Hepatitis A Recall website has been updated for consumers to find out if they may have eaten frozen strawberries currently under recall within the past two weeks. A list of these food businesses is available at [www.michigan.gov/HepArecall](http://www.michigan.gov/HepArecall). This list could change as the investigation continues, including addition and removal of businesses from the list.

At this time, there is only one establishment in St. Clair County identified with an exposure among residents and staff with the affected product; Medilodge of Port Huron, located at 5635 Lakeshore Rd, Fort Gratiot Township. The St. Clair County Health Department has been working with the facility administration providing Hepatitis A vaccinations for those at highest risk.
