

St. Clair County Health Department Possible COVID-19 Cases in Students



Student has any of the following symptoms (new/different/worse than baseline for any chronic illness):

- Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache

Exclude from school

Student has ANY close contact or potential exposure risk in the past 14 days:

- Had close contact with a person with identified COVID-19*
- Traveled to or lives in an area with a high level of community transmission of COVID-19

Student may return to school 24 hours after fever resolution and improvement of symptoms

Yes

Refer to a healthcare provider for possible COVID-19 testing

Negative test for COVID-19

Not tested for COVID-19

Healthcare provider note not provided

Positive test for COVID-19

Student had close contact with confirmed case of COVID-19 in past 14 days

Healthcare provider note indicating another explanation for symptoms

Home isolation until:

- At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared **and**
- At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication **and**
- Symptoms have improved

***Complete quarantine period**

*** Quarantine is 10 days if:** The individual does not develop any symptoms or clinical evidence of COVID-19 infection during daily symptom monitoring for the 10 days after the last exposure. **AND** completes daily symptom monitoring through day 14 after the last exposure.
