The Farmland Preservation Act (PA116) information was derived from a DNR database of lands under PA116 contract, last updated in 1996. Those areas listed as 'Unknown Status' are areas where the Farmland Preservation contract ended before 12/31/1999, or where the contract status or expiration date is unknown. 'Active Status' are those areas where the contract does not expire until 12/31/1999 or later.
