

Commercial Motor Vehicle Enforcement

- 2015 Revenue
 - \$253,801
- Commercial Motor Vehicle program continues to be Self Funded
- Road Commission Partnership
 - Directed enforcement at construction sights
 - Weight enforcement
- Land Fill Partnership
 - Enforcement of the local landfill ordinance has increased revenues





Detective Bureau

Detective Lieutenant overseeing all complaints

Six detectives currently assigned

- The detective bureau handles all major investigations
 - Ranging from violent assaults to home invasions.
 - Criminal Sexual Conduct is the largest individual category
- Detectives are on call 24 hours per day for any criminal complaint



Detective Bureau Specialized Training

Detectives are trained in various areas to handle special aspects of investigations

- 1 Detective trained in computer forensics
 - Forensic examination in computers used in crimes
- 2 Detectives trained in mobile forensic investigations
 - Cell phones, tablets, I-pads, etc.
- Forensic Interviewing Techniques
 - Specialized training used to interview children involved in abuse complaints



Cost Savings

- Civil Division
 - \$175,494 revenue in 2012
 - \$117,459 revenue in 2013
 - \$71,060 revenue in 2014
 - \$59,911 revenue in 2015
- Pre-Hearing Conference Project
 - 2015 \$36,045 overtime savings
 - 2015 111 hours of Patrol time saved






2015 Law Enforcement Calls for Service






2013 to 2015 Criminal Activity






Traffic Violations 2013 - 2015






2012 to 2015 Traffic Crashes






Intoxicated Driving 2013 - 2015












Information Received & Criminal Complaints






Misdemeanor and Felony Charges






Forfeitures






Search Warrants & Traffic Stops






Weapons Confiscated






Value of Property Seized






Marijuana Seized






Methamphetamine

Laboratories




Product (Grams)






Heroin and Analogue Drugs

Heroin (Grams)




Analogue Drugs (Doses)
