

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONCEALED PISTOL APPLICATION

PLEASE READ ALL INFORMATION LISTED BELOW AND IN THE LINK BEFORE BEGINNING THE APPLICATION PROCESS.

Complete the CPL class and application before you submit your application.

(CPL CLASS DOES NOT APPLY FOR RENEWALS). For renewals, if you were fingerprinted after January 1, 2006, you do not have to be fingerprinted again.

Included in the link below is a list of instructors who teach the CPL class. Any other instructor you choose must be NRA certified and the class must be in compliance with Michigan Public Act 372 of 1927 as amended.

For your application to be accepted, the NRA safety class had to be taken on or after July 1, 2001. If the class was taken before that date, you must take the class again.

FOR NEW CPL APPLICATIONS YOU NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- Completed application (unsigned)
- Driver's License
- 1 passport photo (The County Clerk can take your photo for \$10)
- Original safety certificate from the CPL class, (instructor signature, dated and compliance with PA372 on certificate)
- \$105.00 cash or money order

FOR RENEWAL APPLICATIONS YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- Completed application (unsigned)
- Driver's License
- CPL License
- 1 passport photo (The County Clerk can take your photo for \$10)
- \$105.00 cash or money order
