

RESOLUTION 10-25

**REVISING RESOLUTION 81-44 FOR THE ALLOCATION OF THE SENIOR
CITIZEN MILLAGE**

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizen Millage was intended primarily for County Wide Services;

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners recognizes "County Wide Services" to mean any services provided and accessible, without title or definition to Senior Citizen residents within the County of St. Clair; and


WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners also recognizes that it is prudent management to set a monitoring function within a service system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:


1. Senior Citizen Millage shall be used to fund primarily County Wide Senior Citizen Services;
2. Not more than 5% shall be set aside to fund the Commission on Aging Advisory Board and administrative support to that Commission for monitoring;
3. Not more than \$1,000 annually shall be appropriated for Senior Citizen Services classified as other than County Wide in impact. All such non-County programs shall be submitted not later than October 1st for annual funding consideration.
