

RESOLUTION 14 – 37

APPROVING THE CORS AGREEMENT BETWEEN
MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND
THE COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Commissioner Bohm
and supported by Commissioner Gratopp:

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) maintains and operates the Michigan Spatial Network (MSRN) comprised of multiple CORS stations; and

WHEREAS, due to advances in technology, MDOT desires to upgrade and maintain the system with modern hardware and software; and

WHEREAS, due to constraints in the County of St. Clair funding availability, the parties agree it would be mutually beneficial for upgrading and will transfer ownership of the CORS stations to MDOT.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the CORS agreement between the Michigan Department of Transportation and the County of St. Clair is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, William Kauffman, Administrator/Controller for the County of St. Clair be authorized to sign said agreement.


