### **Pfizer Vaccine Now Available for Individuals Ages 12 and Older Walk-in Vaccination Clinic May 13 from 9:00am-7:00pm**

The St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD) will begin offering the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination to individuals 12-15 years of age. This is following the decision by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) to recommend to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) that the Pfizer vaccine be made available to administer to children ages 12-15 years.

St. Clair County Health Department is offering a walk-in vaccination clinic on **Thursday, May 13, from 9:00am- 7:00pm** at the Knight Club, 1195 Gratiot Blvd, Marysville.

#### COVID-19 vaccinations being offered at this clinic include:

- Pfizer vaccine for individuals age 12 and older
  - Youth ages 12-15 years parent/guardian must be present
  - Youth ages 16-17 signed parental consent required
  - Second dose appointments will be scheduled at that time
- Johnson & Johnson vaccine for individuals 18 & older
- Second dose Pfizer and Moderna vaccines also available
