St. Clair County Community Resource Fair 2022

On May 13, 2022, the Housing & Support Workgroup under the St. Clair County Community Services Coordinating Body (CSCB) is hosting its annual Community Resource Fair. The event will run from 10am to 1pm in the parking lot of St. Clair County Community College (SC4) located at 323 Erie Street in Port Huron. The Fair is a one-day, one stop event designed to provide services and supports for individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness, at-risk of becoming homeless, or experiencing extreme financial difficulty.

This year's Fair will be a drive-thru event that will feature a mobile food pantry, personal care items, and resource bags filled with print materials from local agencies. Community First Health Centers will also be onsite to provide free COVID-19 vaccinations for attendees.

"We understand that many in our community are struggling to make ends meet. Due to the strains of COVID-19 and the overall increase in the price of goods, more people are seeking help. Our goal with the Community Resource Fair is to provide essentials like food and hygiene items while also connecting folks with local resources that can provide more long-term solutions" said Bonnie Dinardo, Executive Director of Community and Public Relations at St. Clair County Community College.
