Proper fertilizer application can enhance lawns. Fall is the best time for plants to absorb nutrients and strengthen root systems. Wait until the lawn has been mowed twice before fertilizing in the spring.

Use the Proper Product

Fertilizers labeled, "all purpose" or "lawn and garden," contain too much phosphorus. Look for a fertilizer with zero phosphorus.

Fertilizing Tips

Spreader

Use a spreader to ensure the proper ratio of fertilizer is spread.

Placement

Keep fertilizer on the lawn and off hard surfaces like driveways and roads.

Watering

Most lawns need about one inch of water per week. Short frequent waterings are recommended.
