WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER VACCINATIONS



Common Side Effects

Reactions at the injection site often happen within a few hours after vaccination. Soreness, redness and/or swelling are common.

Use an ice pack or cool, wet washcloth on the area for no more than 10 minutes. Move the arm repeatedly.

Other reactions may include fever, muscle aches, headache and/or loss of appetite.

Drink plenty of fluids, wear loose clothing and take ibuprofen or acetaminophen as needed. Talk to your doctor for appropriate dosing for an infant.

May Occur Following Live Vaccines

After receiving Varicella

- Fever lasting 1-2 days
- Rash within 7-10 days

1-2 weeks after receiving MMR

- Non-contagious rash
- Fever
- Swollen glands
- Joint pain



Call your doctor or go to the emergency room if you or your child develops:

- Hives
- Mouth/throat swelling
- Wheezing
- Low blood pressure
- Fever for more than 24 hours
- Crying for more than 3 hours
- High pitched, unusual cry within 48 hours
- Fussiness/irritability for more than 48 hours
