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2025 Healthcare Professional's Guide to Disease Reporting in Michigan

Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) has released the 2025 version of the Health Care Professional's Guide to Disease Reporting in Michigan. The booklet can be viewed at MDHHS Brick Book. MDHHS is required to annually review, update, and publish the official list of Michigan's mandatory reportable communicable diseases on the department website. The mandatory reporting is described by the Michigan Communicable Disease Rules [Public Act 368 of 1978, 333.5111]. The list is available by Pathogen and by Condition.

Noted changes to the 2025 Michigan Reportable Disease List include the following:

- Anthrax: The addition of anthrax toxin-producing Bacillus species
- HIV Tests: HIV Rapid tests have been added to the list of reportable HIV tests
- Trichinellosis/Trichinosis (Trichinella spiralis): The name "Trichinosis" has been added to the list by condition

- Updated reporting requirements for Carbapenamase-Producing Organisms (CPO) page 12
