- Led by an Environmental Health Educator

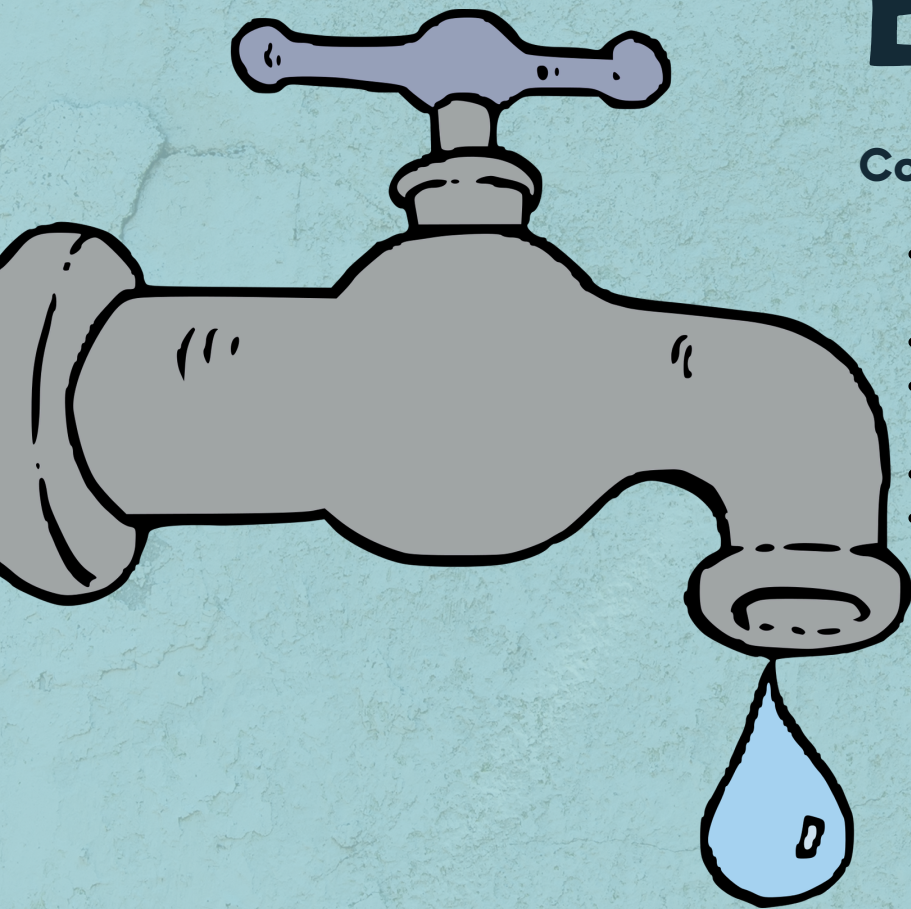
