

# St. Clair County County Health Department Possible COVID-19 Case in the General Public

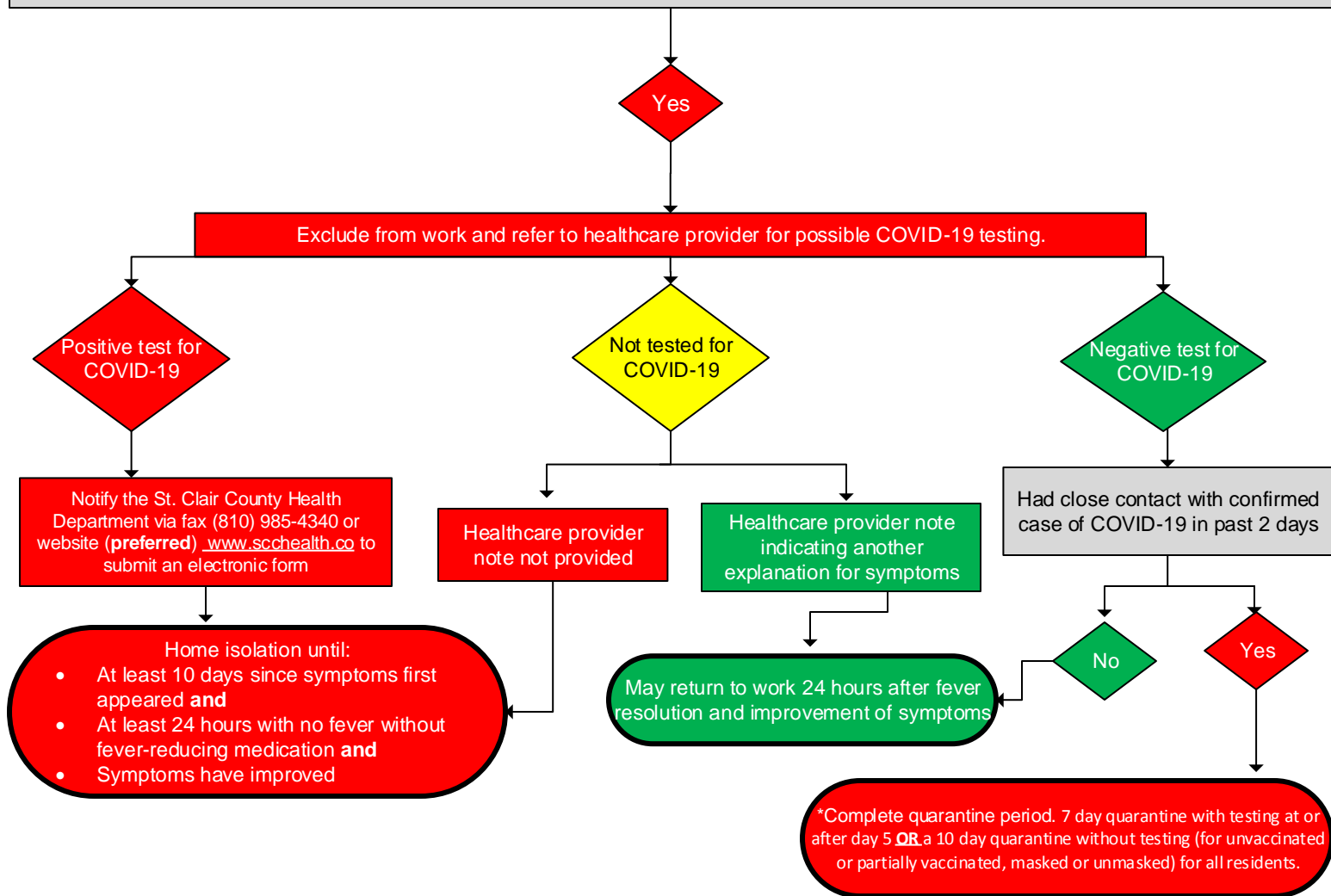
Individual has any of the following symptoms (new/different/worse than baseline for any chronic illness):

**One** of the following

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- New loss of smell
- New loss of taste
- Feverish

OR **Two** or more of the following

- Fever (measured or subjective)
- Chills
- Rigors (shaking or exaggerated shivering)
- Muscle aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose



**\*Exempt from quarantine:**

**Scenario 1:** Individuals identified as close contacts who have recently recovered from COVID-19 will not be required to quarantine if: They do not currently have symptoms AND; Were diagnosed with COVID-19 by either (1) a positive RT-PCR or antigen test for SARS-CoV2 within the last 90 days, or (2) a healthcare provider based on symptoms, and 90 days or less have passed since symptoms began.

**Scenario 2:** Vaccinated persons with an exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 are not required to quarantine, if they meet ALL of the criteria: They are fully vaccinated; at least 14 days since receiving the final dose in the vaccine series (2 doses of Moderna; 2 doses of Pfizer; or 1 dose of Janssen/Johnson & Johnson) and They have not developed any symptoms since their exposure to someone with COVID-19.

\* There should be a record of the case having been reported to public health in order to exempt a close contact from quarantine.
