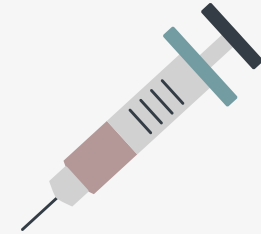


HEPATITIS A

- Dark urine/pee
- Pale-colored stools/poop
- Throwing up/vomiting
- Stomach pain
- Feel tired
- Fever

There is a large hepatitis A outbreak in Michigan. It is a contagious liver disease. Most people can get better after a few months, but it can cause liver damage and death.
