The Reportable Disease Update has been developed to communicate infectious disease information to community healthcare professionals. This update will be distributed quarterly to identify and communicate issues, trends in the community, and emerging communicable diseases that can impact our community.

Information Items:

- CDC is tracking an outbreak of Monkeypox that has spread across several countries, including the United States. CDC, MDHHS, and St. Clair County Health Department are urging healthcare providers to be alert for patients who have rash illnesses consistent with Monkeypox, regardless of whether they have travel or specific risk factors for Monkeypox and regardless of gender or sexual orientation. Monkeypox is transmitted by direct contact, indirect contact, and respiratory secretions during prolonged face-to-face contact. Signs and symptoms of Monkeypox are: fever, headache, fatigue, myalgia, lymphadenopathy, and rash. As of July 12th 2022 Michigan has 6 reported cases.
