

Resolution 16-09

Placing Proposed Renewal for St. Clair County Veteran Affairs Millage

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the County of St. Clair recognizes the need and value to providing financial aid and services to veterans and their families in St. Clair County and to supporting the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veterans Affairs; and

Whereas, voter approved millage funds have provided financial aid to St. Clair County veterans and their families and have also provided financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veteran Affairs allowing the Department to provide high quality services to veterans and their families in St. Clair County; and

Whereas, if not renewed, the previously authorized voter approved millage dedicated to provide financial aid to veterans and their families and to provide financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veterans Affairs expires with the 2016 levy; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners to permit the electorate of the County to express its view on the renewal of a millage the proceeds of which will be used to provide financial aid to veterans and their families as well as provide financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veteran Affairs.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved that:

The Clerk of the County of St. Clair is hereby directed to place on the ballot for the primary election of August 2, 2016, a proposition to renew the imposition of an additional not to exceed .10 mills the proceeds of which will be used to provide financial aid to veterans and their families and to provide financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veteran Affairs:

Proposition 3

RENEWAL OF THE ST. CLAIR COUNTY VETERANS AFFAIRS MILLAGE


Shall the St. Clair County levy a Veterans Affairs Millage of .10 mills per year (\$.10 per thousand dollars of taxable value of taxable real and personal property) constituting a renewal of a previously authorized voter approved millage, for a period of six (6) years, 2017 through 2022 inclusive, generating estimated revenues the first year the renewed millage is authorized and levied of approximately \$562,824. If approved, funds from this millage will be used to provide financial aid to veterans and their families and to provide financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Department of Veterans Affairs.

1. Said election shall be held and conducted and the results of the said election shall be canvassed in accordance with the provisions of the State law pertaining to the submission of such questions to the electors entitled to vote thereon and that the County Clerk of St. Clair County and the Treasurer of St. Clair County shall do and perform all acts required by law for the calling and effecting of such election, and that the said Clerk shall within five (5) days of said election file with the County Treasurer for St. Clair County a certified copy of the official declaration of the results of said election.
