9. At a hearing on a petition to terminate parental rights to the child under MCL 712A.2(b), the court having jurisdiction over the child found that it is in the best interests of the child to allow the request to set aside the order of filiation.

Note: Pursuant to MCL 722.717(5) of the Paternity Act, when an order of filiation is set aside, the clerk of the court that enters the order must immediately communicate this fact to the director of the Department of Health and Human Services on a form prescribed by the director of that department.
