Flu Shot Reimbursement

Retirees and spouses who have Medicare Advantage, the plan covers a shot once per flu season in the fall or winter and the deductible does not apply.

The County has offered to reimburse the cost of the flu vaccination for retirees and spouses who are less than 65 and not covered under the Medicare Advantage plan. Simply send your original receipt to St. Clair County Human Resources —Retirement, 200 Grand River Ave. Ste. 206, Port Huron, MI 48060 for reimbursement through your monthly pension check. Please be advised receipts for flu reimbursement must be received **within 60 days**. Flu vaccines can also be obtained at local pharmacies and at health care provider offices.

Senior Homelessness, Housing Matters

Homeless Solutions - Senior homelessness affects communities throughout the country, and St. Clair County is no exception. As populations age and economic challenges persist, an increasing number of seniors face homelessness or housing instability. Addressing this requires compassionate approaches prioritizing supportive services, affordable housing options, and robust community partnerships.

Local organizations like Housing Matters, Inc. and Sanborn Gratiot Memorial Home play crucial roles. Housing Matters' Foundations program in Port Huron provides temporary housing and support services funded by St. Clair County Senior Citizens' Millage. Meanwhile, Sanborn Gratiot Memorial Home offers on-site care, including medication administration, personal care, meals, and activities, aiming to transition seniors to stable housing. These efforts are bolstered by collaborations with agencies like the Public Guardian and Blue Water Safe Horizons, ensuring comprehensive support and developing long-term housing solutions for vulnerable seniors.

Last year, 21 homeless seniors received emergency placement and transitioned permanent housing. Together, our community strives to ensure every senior has a dignified and secure place to call home in their later years with the support of the millage funds.

Medicare Open Enrollment

Open enrollment for Medicare Advantage is upon us. You will be receiving a lot of marketing calls and materials from companies trying to get you to switch to their plan. It is your right to decide on a plan that suits you, but please keep in mind that an individual can only be enrolled in one Medicare Advantage plan at a time. Enrolling in another Medicare Advantage plan may automatically disenroll you from the St. Clair County Retiree Medicare Advantage plan. If you wish to remain on the County Policy, there is no action you need to take. If a covered dependent newly becomes Medicare eligible through age or disability, you should notify our office immediately.

Please be aware that scammers will be at an all-time high during this enrollment period and will impersonate Medicare or another organization you may know. No one should be asking for your Medicare, Social Security, bank or credit card information-DO NOT share this information. <u>They do not need any personal information to provide a</u> <u>quote.</u>
