Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a current 4-H member
- Active member in the 4-H Dog Project Area
- Must have attended at least one 4-H Dog Committee meeting and participate in at least one of the committee fund raising efforts.
- May be applied for annually until the age of 19 (4-H age as of January 1 of current year)
- All material must be in original form. No faxes etc.

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE IS COMPRISED OF 4-H DOG COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND MSUE 4-H STAFF.

All scholarship monies awarded at the discretion of the committee. Applications scored by the following criteria:

Involvement in the 4-H Dog & other project areas	30 points
GPA	10 points
School / Church / Community Involvement	15 points
Letters of Recommendations	20 points
Essay	25 points
Interview	25 points

Interviews granted at the discretion of the committee based on scoring. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Letters will be sent to those applicants granted an interview. All applications are required to confirm their interview appointments. No phone interviews allowed. Interview is mandatory. Those applicants granted an interview may receive a maximum of 25 points for the interview portion. Winners will be announced at the awards presentation Saturday of fair.
