New indoor masking guidelines for MSU

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to shift and change, Michigan State University issued new guidance for the broader MSU community on October 13. These changes impact attendees of MSU Extension programs occurring on non-MSU property. Effective immediately, the following guidelines apply to indoor MSU Extension or Michigan

Those who participate in MSU Extension programming indoors on MSU property or any property reserved/rented for an MSU event are required to wear a face covering. This

vaccination status (unless they have a medical exemption).

Those who participate in MSU Extension programming

indoors on non-MSU property are encouraged but not re-

quired to wear masks unless required by local regulations
