What is it?

- •A plan that outlines planning principles, goals, and objectives for the next 25 years, and is updated every four years.
- •Guiding document for transportation planning in St. Clair County
- Enables funding
- Locally developed policy
- Goals & objectives
- Current conditions
- Recommendations
- Implementation strategy

Why do we need it?

- •Federal transportation legislation
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)- 2022-2026
 - The BIL continues the Metropolitan Planning Program, which establishes a cooperative, continuous, and comprehensive framework for making transportation investment decisions in metropolitan areas. Program oversight is a joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration responsibility.

•It's important to re-examine the county's transportation goals/objectives, current needs, and future trends

• Support economic prosperity through strategic transportation investment

PLAN GOALS

- I. Preserve transportation infrastructure in ways that are cost-effective and match our community's needs.
- II. Increase Safety for all travelers, regardless of mode.
- III. Ensure that everyone, regardless of differences like race, gender, ethnicity, national origin, age, physical or cognitive ability, or income can easily reach essential services and employment opportunities.
- IV. Use technology to enhance the transportation system in a cost-effective way.
- V. Create a transportation system that is resilient, protects the environment, and improves community health.


PLAN GOALS

- VI. Help the regional economy by making sure goods move smoothly and efficiently, making trade connections better, allowing more people to work in different places, and supporting tourism, and placemaking.
- VII. Educate and work with local governments, transportation agencies, utility providers, and residents to make the transportation system better.
- VIII. Increase spending and options for local governments to meet the transportation needs of their communities.
- IX. Prepare for challenges that occur as the region's population gets older, like not being able to move around as easily and not having enough workers.
- X. Determine how safe and effective the transportation system is by collecting and studying data to make smart investments.






ROAD CONDITION PAVEMENT AND SURFACE EVALUATION RATING (PASER)




MOST RECENT ROAD CONDITIONS






EASTERN HALF

















WESTERN HALF
