# St. Clair County Transportation Study

- Being a Transportation Study Area there are three documents that the Federal Highway Administration requires:
  - **Long Range Transportation Plan-** A plan that outlines planning principles, goals, and objectives for the next 25 years. Is updated every four years.
  - **Transportation Improvement Program-** A list of federally funded transportation projects for a four year time period, developed with fiscal constraints.
  - **Unified Planning Work Program-** A document that outlines the planning activities that we plan to accomplish each year; developed every year for the upcoming fiscal year. SEMCOG's Fiscal Year is July 1-June 30.

# 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan

## *Why Update the Plan*

- Federal transportation legislation
  - ▣ Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)- 2022-2026
    - The BIL continues the Metropolitan Planning Program, which establishes a cooperative, continuous, and comprehensive framework for making transportation investment decisions in metropolitan areas. Program oversight is a joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration responsibility.
- It's important to re-examine our goals/objectives, current needs, and future trends

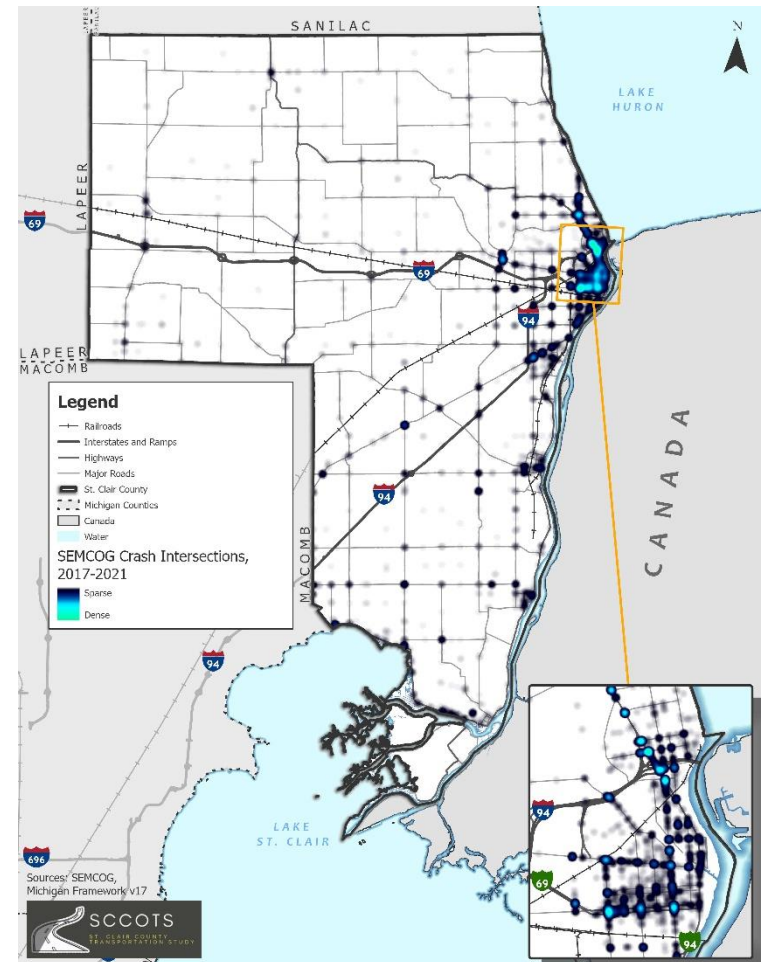
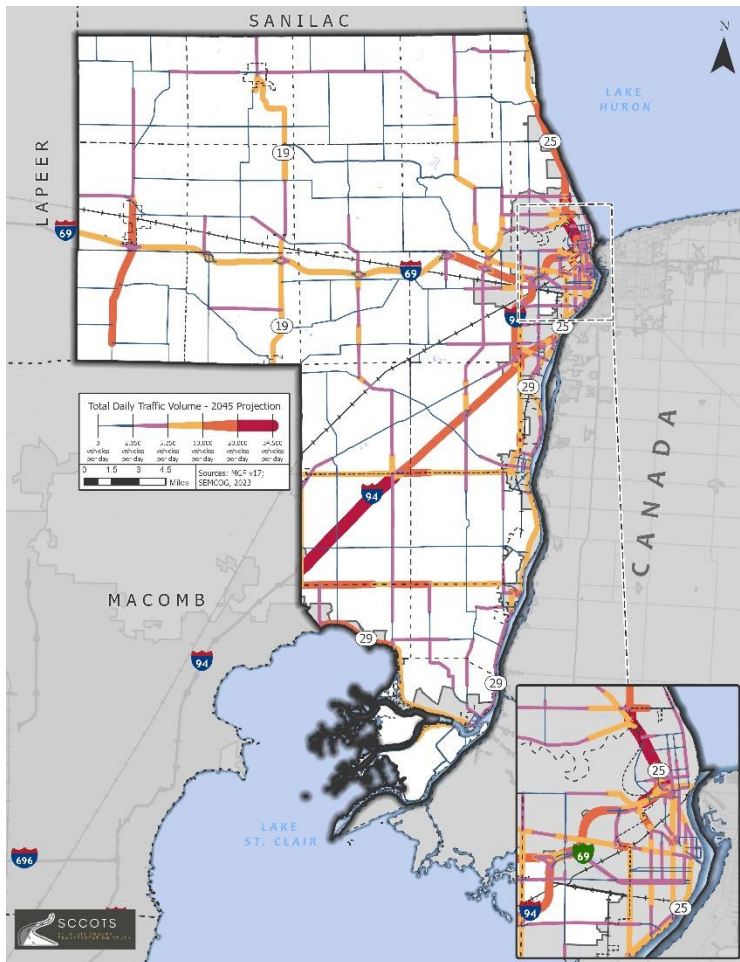




# More Equity Maps
