## CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) ADVISORY

St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD) continues to work closely with state and federal officials to monitor the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Testing for COVID-19 has expanded in Michigan and the risk remains low locally.

## Guidance:

- Healthcare providers (HCP) should:
  - Obtain a detailed travel history on patients being evaluated with fever and acute respiratory illness and <u>report any suspect cases</u> of COVID-19 to SCCHD.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Test for other causes of respiratory illness.
  - Educate and inform patients testing for COVID-19 that, the expectation is to selfisolate and practice social distancing including from housemates until test results are known.
  - Inform patient that isolation enforcement, monitoring, and needs assessments are conducted by SCCHD. A staff member will make contact via phone.
